KEY STEPS FOR HANDLING, PLANTING AND PROTECTION OF SEEDLINGS



1 HANDLING OF SEEDLINGS



Handle seedlings with care to avoid damaging polythene or Pot Mixer.



Water seedlings by sprinkling once daily.



No watering two days before transportation.



Beneficiaries shall water seedlings lightly once a day and keep them in the shade.



No watering one day before planting.



2 HANDLING OF SEEDLINGS



Dig a 1 foot x1 foot x1 foot pit at least 1 day before planting, mix pit soil with organic manure.



Remove soil from the pit one day before planting.



Carefully slit polythene without disturbing the soil.



Fill the pit with soil mix, leaving the root collar at ground level.



Remove polythene, place seedling, and fill the pit to prevent water-logging.



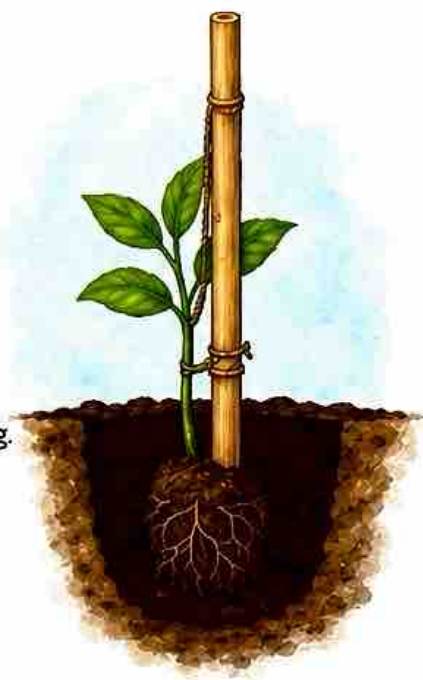
Gently compact soil around the stem.



Provide support with a taller bamboo stick, and tie with jute string.



Water seedlings gently.



3 PROTECTION OF SEEDLINGS



Create a DIY (Do it yourself) tree guard at home with three/four (Triangle/square) sticks around the seedling, leaving space for growth.



Wrap the sticks around the sides with agro-net fabric/jute bags.



Regularly care for and protect seedlings from grazing and fire until they grow into trees.
